

RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF RESEARCH PARTICIPANTS

RIGHTS OF RESEARCH PATIENTS

- Right to information about the research study in an understandable language
- Right to informed consent before participation in any research study
- Right to information on the expected cost, duration, alternative treatment available and travelling compensation or any other compensation provided for participation
- Right to personal dignity, privacy and confidentiality
- Right to get the information on the plan of care
- Right to uniform care for all classes of patients
- Right to information on how to voice a complaint against any violation of the rights and integrity
- Right to get 24 hours emergency contact details of the Research Doctor
- Right to refusal of participation or withdrawal of participation at any point of time during the study without disclosing the reason
- Right to get information on medical management of any injury and compensation in case of any study related injury or death
- Right to confidentiality of patient information/details recorded in the hospital
- Right to access clinical records

RESPONSIBILITIES OF RESEARCH PATIENTS

- To Provide complete and accurate information about:
 - Your health, including present and past illness, hospitalisation, medication, allergies and surgeries
 - Full name, address and other demographic information
- To follow the prescribed treatment plan, schedule and instructions given by doctors carefully
- To ask questions when he/she does not understand what the Doctor or any other healthcare team member tells about the diagnosis or treatment
- Not to take any medications without the prior knowledge of the Doctor and healthcare professional
- To accept the measures taken by the Hospital to ensure personal privacy and confidentiality of medical records
- To inform your study doctor immediately in case of any injury or development of any new medical condition
- Treat the Hospital staff, other patients and visitors with courtesy
